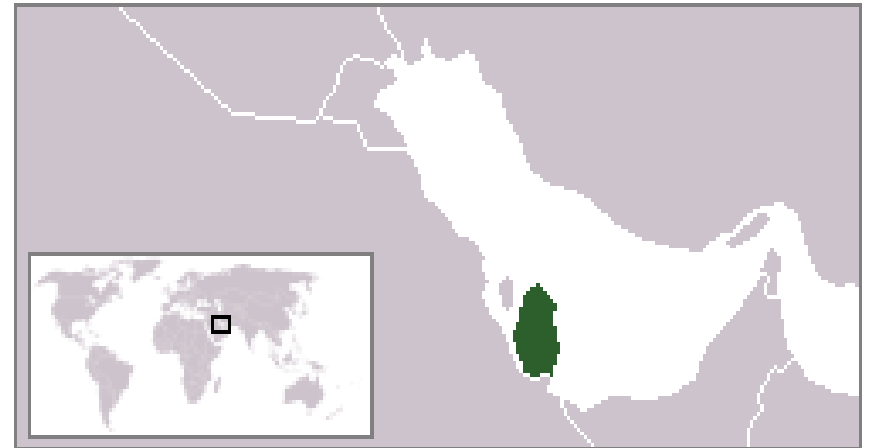

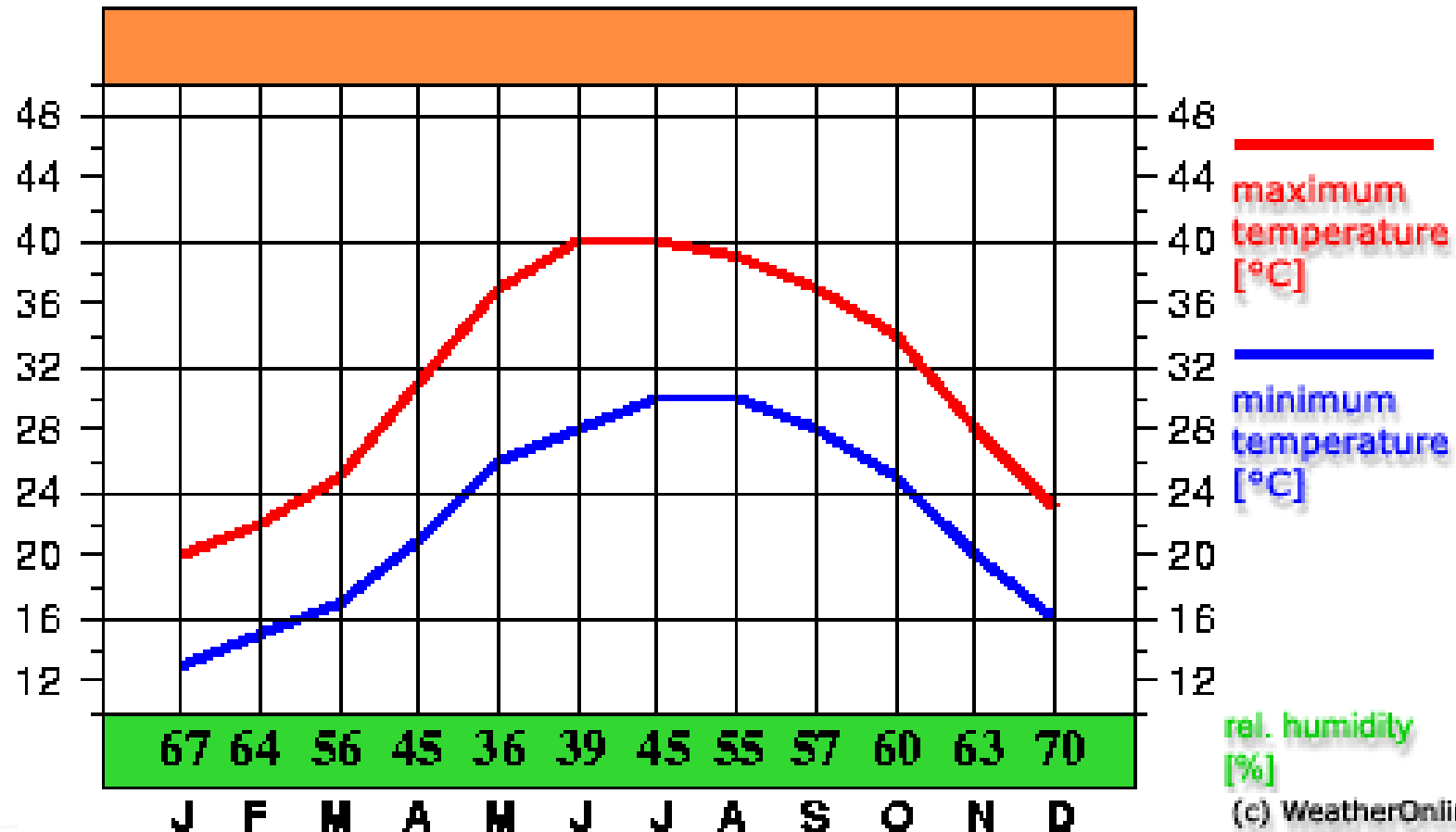
Qatar

(Arab World == 0.2 %)

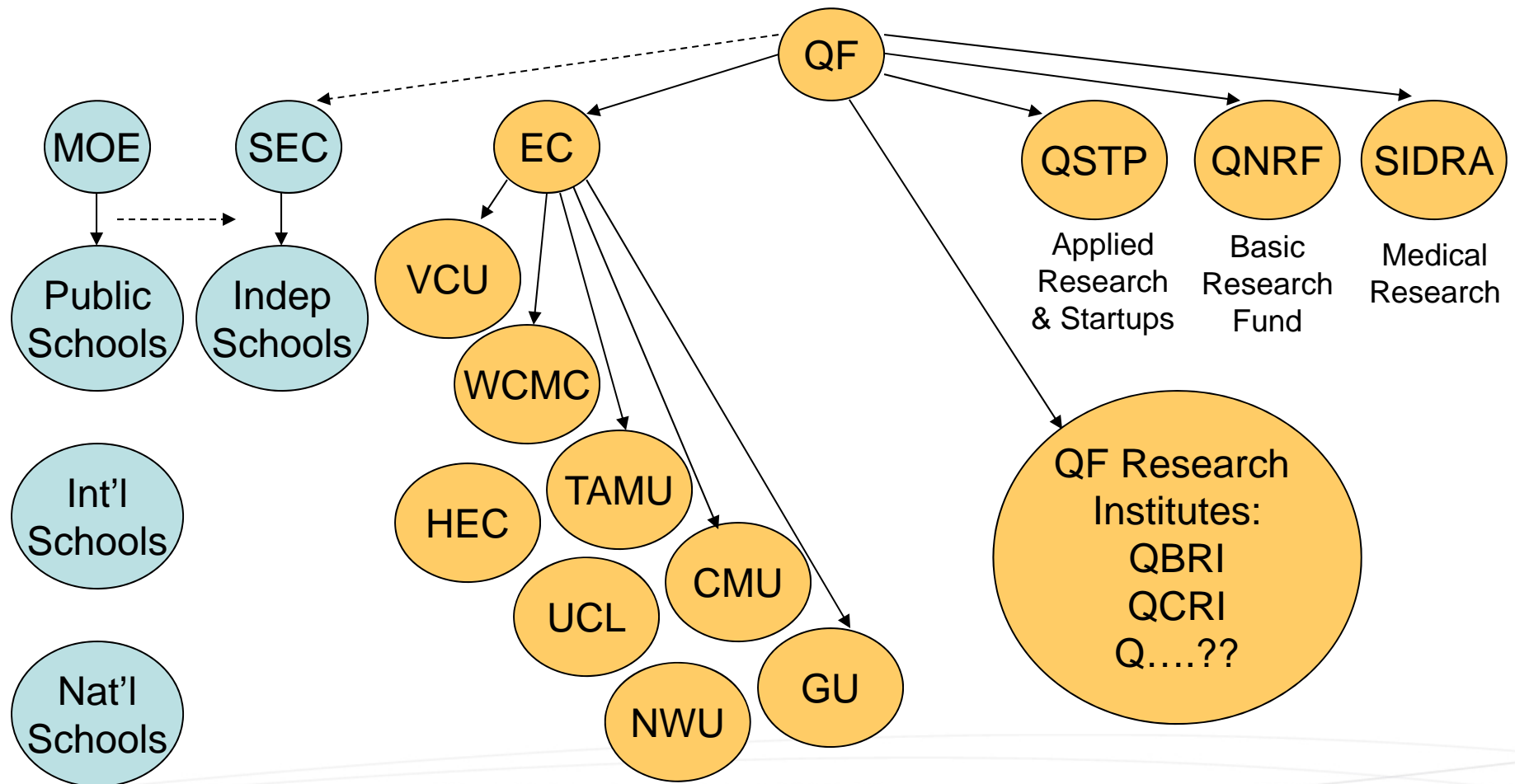
